

PRESS SIFT KEY 5 TIMES (USE ONLY SINGLE FUNCTION)

- After press 5 time "Shift" Key, then hear a beep sound and Sticky Key on.
- Sticky Key Means 4 key of the Key board (i.e SHIFT, CTRL, ALT or WINDOW) these are also known as modify keys.
- You know these key are multiple use, after activate the sticky key, where use these 4 key, it use only single function or locked single sticky key.
- After yes the sticky key, you show a sticky key option available on task bar.
- Press shift key or sticky key one time – Lock or Activate Shift Key
- Press Shift key or sticky key two time- Unlock or deactivate Shift Key
- Open Task Bar- Ctrl+Alt+ Delet

How to off the Sticky Key:

- Shift+Ctrl

Permanent Disable:

- Go to Control Panel
- Each of Access Centre
- Make the key keyboard easier to type
- Set up Sticky Keys
